The Levent Campus

The schools' facilities are regularly modernized. There are classrooms with advanced technologies, laboratories, libraries (60,000 titles including e-books) meeting rooms, 8 insulated music rooms, 4 large theatre and conference halls, dining halls with a total capacity of 1600 people, an IT centre, a cultural centre, and a professionally managed art gallery. The Sports Complex includes a fitness centre, a sauna, massage rooms, three swimming pools, one of which is indoor, a professional pitch, two tennis courts and an artificial rock climbing wall.

The Tepeören Campus

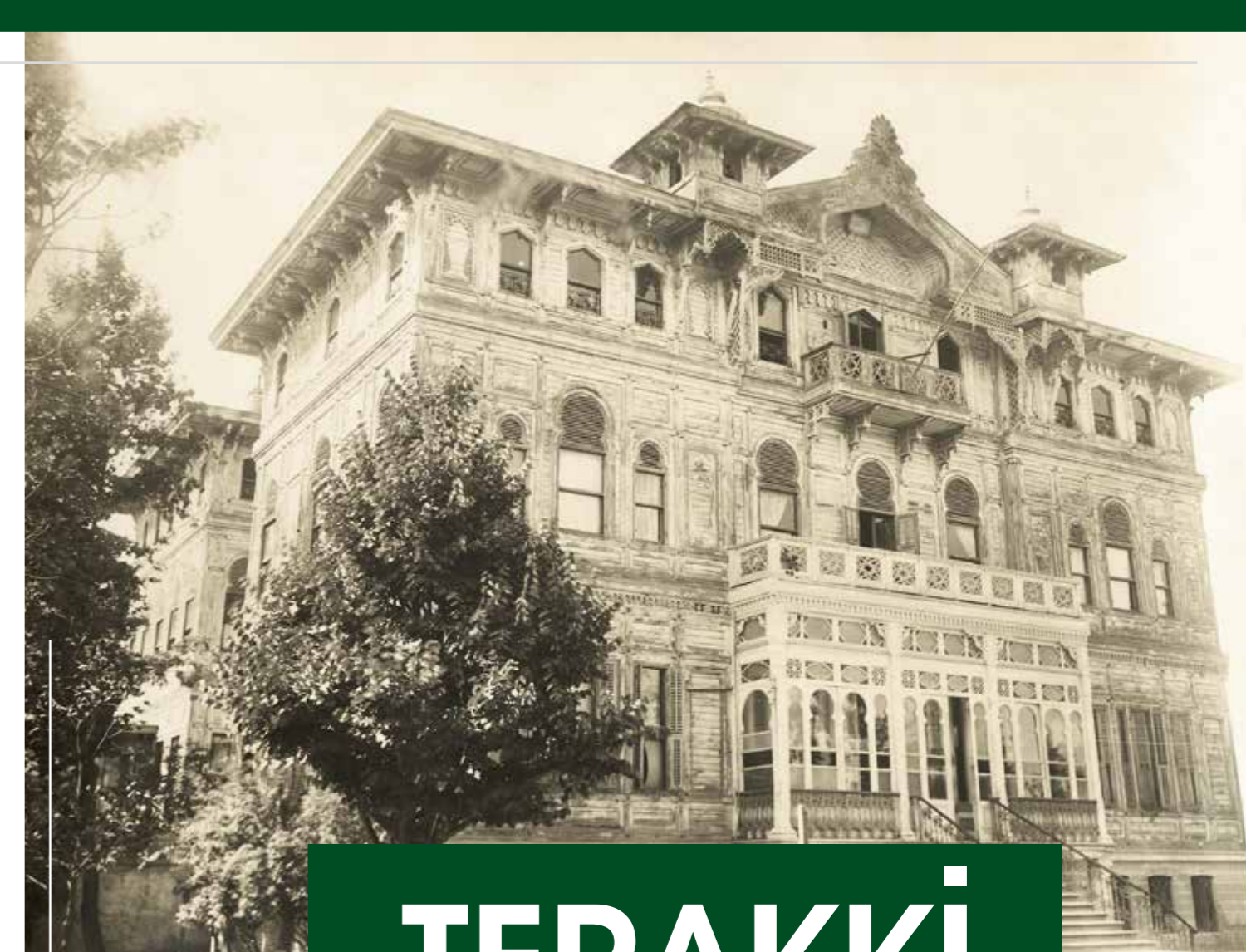
The Tepeören campus was opened as a second campus in 2014 in Tepeören, Tuzla to meet the educational demands of students living specifically on the Asian side of Istanbul and in neighboring cities such as Gebze and Kocaeli. It is a modern campus with state-of-the-art facilities including smart classrooms, science labs, libraries, music and rehearsal rooms, IT labs, conference halls, ceramic and art studios, an indoor and an outdoor pool and other sports facilities. Most importantly, it is an environmentally friendly campus with a LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Gold Certificate.

Terakki Foundation Schools

The Terakki Foundation Schools have a distinguished place in the educational history of Turkey. The first Terakki School was founded in 1877 in Salonica under the name "Mekteb-i Terakki" (Terakki: Progress), and was relocated to Istanbul in 1921, adopting the name "Sisli Terakki School".

Today, the Terakki Foundation Schools are leading co-educational, non-profit K-12 day schools, which operate on two campuses, keeping pace with global educational and social advances. One of the two campuses is in Levent, in the center of Istanbul, on the European side (total enrollment 2670), and the second campus is in Tepeoren, on the Asian side of the city (total enrollment 1141).

The Anatolian High School Diploma and the IB Diploma Program are offered on both campuses. The Levent campus also offers the Science High School Diploma to a select group of high-achieving students. The Turkish National Curriculum content is actively supplemented through the ongoing development of the schools' own original academic curricula tied to the highest international standards.

The medium of instruction is Turkish, with the exception of the IBDP subjects, which are taught in English. English as a foreign language is taught extensively to further improve students' communicative, academic, and cognitive skills. French, German and Spanish are also offered as second foreign languages.

ANATOLIAN HIGH SCHOOL & SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students are accepted according to their results on Turkey's highly competitive national high school entrance exam (LGS). Both our Anatolian High Schools and Science High School on the Levent campus are among highly selective private schools in Turkey, admitting approximately the top 2% of students. One third of the entering class represent the top 0.5-1% and they receive 100% merit-based scholarships.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Terakki Schools offer over 50 student clubs to enrich students' academic experiences. Each student can become a member of one student club per academic year.

IBDP students are not allowed to join student clubs during weekly student club hours due to their academic workload.

COVID-19 UPDATES

The Turkish Ministry of Education decided to close K-12 schools for face-to-face education between March 16 and June 19, 2020, and for the entire 2020-21 academic year, for some grade levels due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, the teaching model for most of the second semester of the 2019-2020 academic year and the whole 2020-21 academic year for grades 9, 10 and 11 was online. No exams could be conducted in the second semester of the 2019-20 academic year, so the grades of the first semester were carried over to calculate the final grades of that year. Exams could be conducted in the 2020-21 and 2021-22 academic years.

Despite the difficulties of online teaching, the full academic program could be delivered and completed at Terakki Schools using online teaching platforms. The schools reopened for face-to-face education as of September 6, 2021.
